Social "U" is a 501(c)3 non-profit group that was specifically created to provide a social outlet for adults with intellectual/developmental disabilities in the Tuscola County area. Our first meeting was held in May of 2015 and had 32 members attend, since that date our membership has grown to over 60 members. At least once a month our amazing group gets together to celebrate a different theme - we have dances, game nights, ice cream socials, carnivals and our own version of the Olympics along with many other fun themes. The group has also gone on special outings: we have attended a Leoni's baseball game, visited an orchard, bowling and been in parades to name a few. Our group also believes in "giving back", at least once a year we do a "community give back" project. Some of the recipients of our give back projects are residents at the TCMGF, local veterans, and most recently we adopted a highway.



## Who We Serve.....
